



Provides real-time imaging, making it an ideal tool to guide minimally invasive procedures such as needle biopsies and fluid aspiration.



Allows for a dynamic examination that can show the movement of soft tissue structures.






US exam: Lateral meniscal cyst with a horizontal fissure
 Transducer: L18-5
 Treatment: US-guided needle aspiration followed by a corticoid injection





Patient: Female, 30 years



US exam: Thicker retinaculum of the thumb extensor tendon that causes pain on the outer side of the wrist
 Transducer: L15-7io
 Diagnosis: De Quervain's Tenosynovitis, type 2
 Treatment: US-guided injection to target the sheath of the short thumb extensor





Patient: Female, 37 years



US exam: Positive Doppler due to joint inflammatory with a cortical erosion of the MTP-1's medial side
 Transducer: L18-5
 Diagnosis: Left MTP-1 Arthritis
 Treatment: US-guided injection



Patient: Female, 75 years



US exam: Paresthesia in three fingers
 Transducer: L18-5
 Diagnosis: Carpal tunnel syndrome
 Treatment: US-guided injection
