Representing over **36%** of the world's population

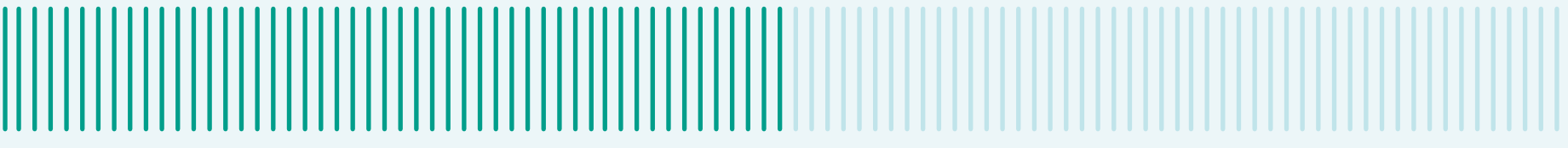


Showed that **disease prevention** is high on the healthcare agenda

50% of the population felt healthcare professionals should **focus on preventative care**

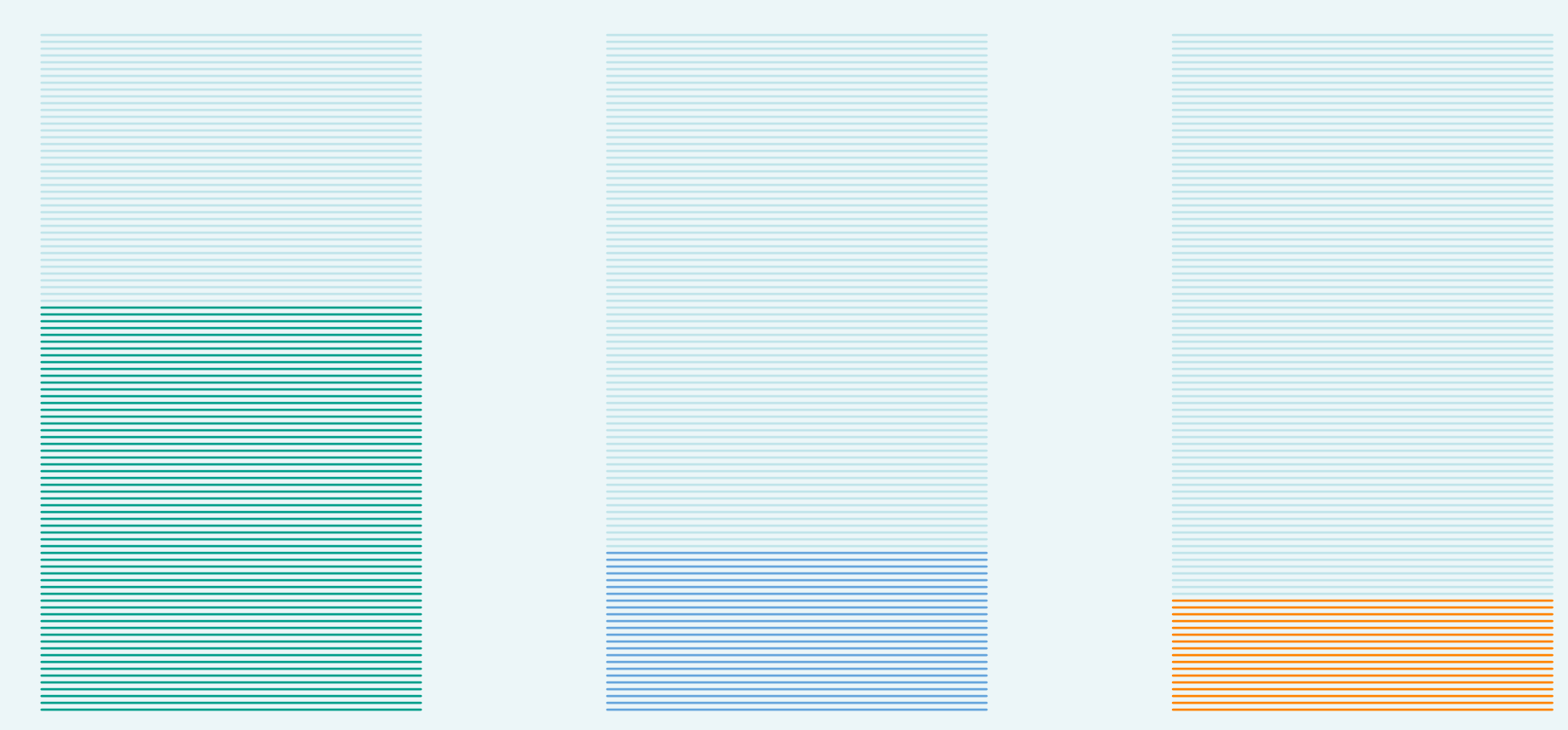
But we need to **empower** healthcare professionals

The study was conducted in partnership with an independent global market research firm in 19 countries in recent months. More than 3,800 healthcare professionals and 29,000 patients total were surveyed in Argentina, Australia, Brazil, Canada, China, France, Germany, Italy, The Netherlands, Russia, Saudi Arabia, Singapore, South Africa, South Korea, Spain, Sweden, UAE, UK and USA.
